#### **Event overview. Simon Sweetman**

There has been a substantial increase in the number of small companies and as a result of that and the effective disappearance of the need for audit in most cases, many accountants who have not in the past had corporate clients now find that they have.

This also means that there are many taxpayers running limited companies with not very much idea about what that means.

This needs to cover both trading and investment companies, and it needs to cover the tax efficient extraction of funds by proprietors/directors both during the lifetime of the company and at the end of its useful life (where it will look at the conditions for obtaining BATR).

It needs to talk about actually tax efficient ways to do it and also to look at various myths and unsound practices about what to do.

It will deal with the problems caused by IR35 and the settlements legislation, and also the problem of overdrawn loan accounts.

It needs to discuss the approach taken by HMRC in this area.

Simon is an independent tax consultant advising mainly small professional firms and those in trouble with HMRC.

He is also tax spokesman for the Federation of Small Businesses. He learned his trade

with the inland Revenue but left in 1989.


